

Flagging At Providence

A. The Foundation

- a. Flags are a form of worship. You and I were created to worship the Lord (Psalms 86:9)! The foundation of worship is Love—knowing we are deeply loved by the Father and reciprocating that love back to Him. Song of Solomon 6:2 says, “I am my beloved’s and he is mine.”
- b. Our Father wrote us a Love Letter (the Bible). Purpose to read His letter daily! Spend time with Him, listening to His Word, having conversations with Him. Allow His heart to become your heart.

B. Why Do We Flag?

- a. To usher in others into the Presence of God. Song of Solomon 2:4 says, “His banner over me is Love.”
- b. Psalms 20:5 “We lift up our banners in the name of the Lord.”
- c. Worshiping with flags may seem controversial, but when done to glorify and honor God they can be a beautiful expression of worship to the Lord! This is our call as believers (Psalms 103:1).

C. Are Flags Biblical/Meaningful?

- a. Flags make a statement. They can declare a time of battle in spiritual warfare (Ephesians 6:12), and they also proclaim the grace (Hebrews 4:16), holiness, and power of Jesus in a time of worship.
- b. We Lift a Banner. When we worship with banners/flags we lift them up in obedience to honor and glorify God. The movement of this type of worship literally ushers in the movement of the Holy Spirit within the body and space thereof. We are collectively drawn into the presence and sovereignty of God (Psalms 20:5, Jeremiah 50:2 & 51:12).
